

THREE SHIRES MEDICAL PRACTICE - RECORD SHARING

There are currently 3 separate NHS initiatives regarding the way in which it is proposed that information in your medical record is held and shared with other agencies. You should have received a letter regarding the first two. You will be receiving a letter about the third initiative. Information sheets about the third (care.data) are available from the surgery or from the surgery website www.threeshiresmedical.co.uk. As this may seem confusing, we have tried to clarify each separate initiative below and to give you a simple means of opting out of any of them if you so wish.

1. Summary Care Record

This is a NATIONAL system that will take only medication and allergies information from your record so that information is available to clinicians if you are taken ill anywhere else in the country.

2. Connecting Care Record

This is a LOCAL system that will enable clinicians to look at the key information from your record e.g if you suffer from diabetes or a heart complaint. Information about this was on the back of the letter about the Summary Care Record. This data will be available to LOCAL Hospitals and local Out of Hours services, who may deal with you at any time in the future. It is currently a "viewing" only service – data is not uploaded en masse, but the hospital (with your permission at the time) would be able to bring up the summary page from your GP practice record.

3 'care.data' or HSCIC (Health and Social Care Information Centre)

You have a choice to make whether to allow your data to go to HSCIC or beyond. Care.data is a NATIONAL system that will take unidentifiable patient information from your medical record. This will include your details regarding chronic diseases, height and weight, blood pressure etc, but not free text. It will be uploaded from April 2014 onwards into a central system at the HSCIC for central health planning and health research. Hospitals and Social Services are also sending data to HSCIC. Your data may also then be passed on to third parties or companies who may use it for statistical purposes. Please read the leaflet that explains this before making a decision on what your wishes are.

You can opt out of your data being transferred out of the practice for any one, or all, of these schemes. If you wish to opt out of any of the above please tick the relevant options, sign below and hand the form into reception
